Teaching Provide courses at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Professional preparation field work experiences are also provided, ranging from a one semester opportunity under the leadership of trained UYDP members to an in-depth development, implementation, and evaluation of their own programs.

<u>Applied Research</u>: Investigate the impact of UYDP youth programs by conducting various qualitative, quantitative, and mixed methodology studies.
